Objectives: The objectives of course are as follows:

1. to help students establish a rational and methodical approach to English writing;

- 3. to introduce fundamental concepts and basic skills in English rhetoric and logical arguments to be applied to English writing.

Instruction: The instruction focuses mainly on topics related to grammar and rhetoric issues that require discussion for better solutions. Questions asked by the students or prepared by the instructor will also be discussed in class. Occasionally, top-down theories regarding generally English grammar and meanings will be covered in the instruction.

Assignment: Students will be required to complete assigned homework and then upload it to the e-learning account. Reading materials will be assigned each week and quizzes will be given each week.
