Dr. Lee is currently a Distinguished Professor at the Institute of Natural Resource Management, National Taipei University. Working with his students and associates, Prof. Lee concentrates on analyzing problems related to environmental policies and natural resource management. The topics his group focuses on include Environmental Impact Assessment, Environmental Systems Analysis, Industrial Ecology, Life Cycle Assessment (including Environmental Footprints), Materials Flow Analysis, Corporate Social Responsibility (Corporate Sustainability), Energy Management Systems, GHG Reduction Management, and Net-Zero Emission Strategies. In addition to his research, Prof. Lee teaches a wide variety of courses, such as Cleaner Production and Industrial Ecology, and Environmental Hazards and Risk Management.

Dr. Lee received a B.S. in Civil Engineering (1987) and an M.S. in Environmental Engineering (1991) from National Taiwan University, followed by an M.A. in Mathematics and Economics for Public Decision Making (1993) and a Ph.D. in Environmental Systems Analysis (1995) from Johns Hopkins University. In 1996, Dr. Lee was appointed Associate Professor of Natural Resource Management at National Chung-Hsing University. After seven years of teaching and research, he was promoted to full professor in 2002. To commend his outstanding contributions to research and teaching, National Taipei University awarded him the lifelong honor of Distinguished Professor in 2015. Additionally, Dr. Lee served as the Chair of the Institute of Natural Resource Management at National Taipei University for 27 semesters, spanning six terms between 2000 and 2025.

Beyond his academic experience, Prof. Lee has served six terms as a commissioner on the Environmental Impact Assessment Review Committee for the Taiwan government (2007–2011, 2013–2017, 2019–2023). He also served two terms as the chairman of the Chinese Institute of Asia-Pacific New Economics (2005–2007, 2014–2016). Additionally, Prof. Lee assisted in the organization of the Center for Corporate Sustainability under the Taiwan Institute for Sustainable Energy, serving as its Secretary General from 2015 to 2020.
